

DENTAL RESOURCES

Grand Peaks Dental Clinic 104 N. Bridge (Suite 117) St. Anthony 208-624-2000

(Located in the Fort Henry Building – entry is from the City parking lot.) Operates 7 am to 4 pm M-F. Dental services offered to Medicaid, dental insurance and private pay patients. Sliding fee scale for qualified low-income patients. (Adult and children referrals.) www.grandpeaks.org

Pocatello Family Dentistry 465 Memorial Drive Pocatello 208-282-6000

Dental Residency Program. Operates 3 days per week (days change). No sliding fee scale for emergency care – emergencies will be charged at a regular rate and must be paid the day of service. There is a long waiting list, but sliding fee schedule is available for non-emergency care (patients may have to qualify for a specific service that the dental resident needs to gain experience in before work can be done). Medicaid and insurance accepted. (Adult and children referrals.)

Eastern Idaho Technical College Dental Assisting Program Clinic Idaho Falls 524-3000 x 3341

Operates on Friday mornings during Spring semester only (January – May). For low-income and uninsured patients. Clinics held to fulfill clinical experience requirements for Dental Assisting students. Local dentists provide volunteer dental services with student participation. Call for more information and clinic schedule. (Adult and children referrals.)

Idaho Falls Dental Hygiene Clinic (at EITC Dental Assisting Program) Idaho Falls 208-282-3282

A teaching facility of Idaho State University Department of Dental Hygiene offers exams, cleaning, X-Rays and dental referrals at reduced fees for adults and children completed by ISU Dental Hygiene students (checked by ISU instructors). Payment required at time of service – the clinic will submit private insurance claims but not Medicaid.

www.dentaquest.com Dentaquest administers the dental benefits for participants of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare Medicaid Basic and Pregnant women Plans. The participant receives an Idaho Smiles card with a customer service number for a list of participating dentists. (A provider directory can be accessed at the above web address. The **Idaho Careline (211)** can also be contacted for a list of dentists accepting medical cards. (Medicaid referrals – adults and children.)
