 - d. R7BHB Gaps and Needs Analysis
 - e. R7BHB Mission and Vision Statements
 - f. Idaho Statutes pertaining to the R7BHB (39-3132,39-3133,39-3134,39-3135 and 39-3125)
2. New board members will complete the following within the first 30 days of being appointed to the board.
 - a. Review R7BHB Mission and Vision
 - b. Review R7BHB Bylaws
 - c. Review R7BHB Gaps and Needs Analysis
 - d. Review R7BHB Strategic Plan
3. New board members will be introduced at their first R7BHB meeting.
4. The R7BHB chair will meet with the new member to welcome them, give a brief overview of the R7BHB and to answer any questions.
